WELCOME TO THE HISTORIC AREA

- Williamsburg was the capital of Virginia from 1699 to 1780. Some lived and worked here by choice, others were brought or kept here by force, and some had been here long before any newcomers arrived.
- The Historic Area includes 89 original 18th-century buildings, as well as hundreds more buildings reconstructed based on historical records and archaeological research.
- People of the past, practicing tradespeople, and historical interpreters are eager to share their knowledge of our history. Ask questions and add your voice to the American experiment.

TIPS FOR A GREAT VISIT

- First visit? Must-see sites include the Governor's Palace, Peyton Randolph House, Courthouse, Raleigh Tavern, Capitol, a program at the Kimball Theatre, and a trade shop.
- Look for a Grand Union Flag  to identify open sites.
- Program tickets can be purchased online or at any ticket office.
- At Colonial Williamsburg, we are committed to creating an environment where together, we can explore our complex history in a manner that is respectful for all. Violators of this policy will be asked to leave the premises.

READING THE PROGRAM TIMES

- When a start time is listed, such as **3:00 (45 MIN)**, it means the program will begin at the time indicated and late arrivals may not be accommodated.
- When a timeframe is listed, such as **12:00 – 3:00**, it means the program runs continuously during that timeframe and you may enter and exit at any point.

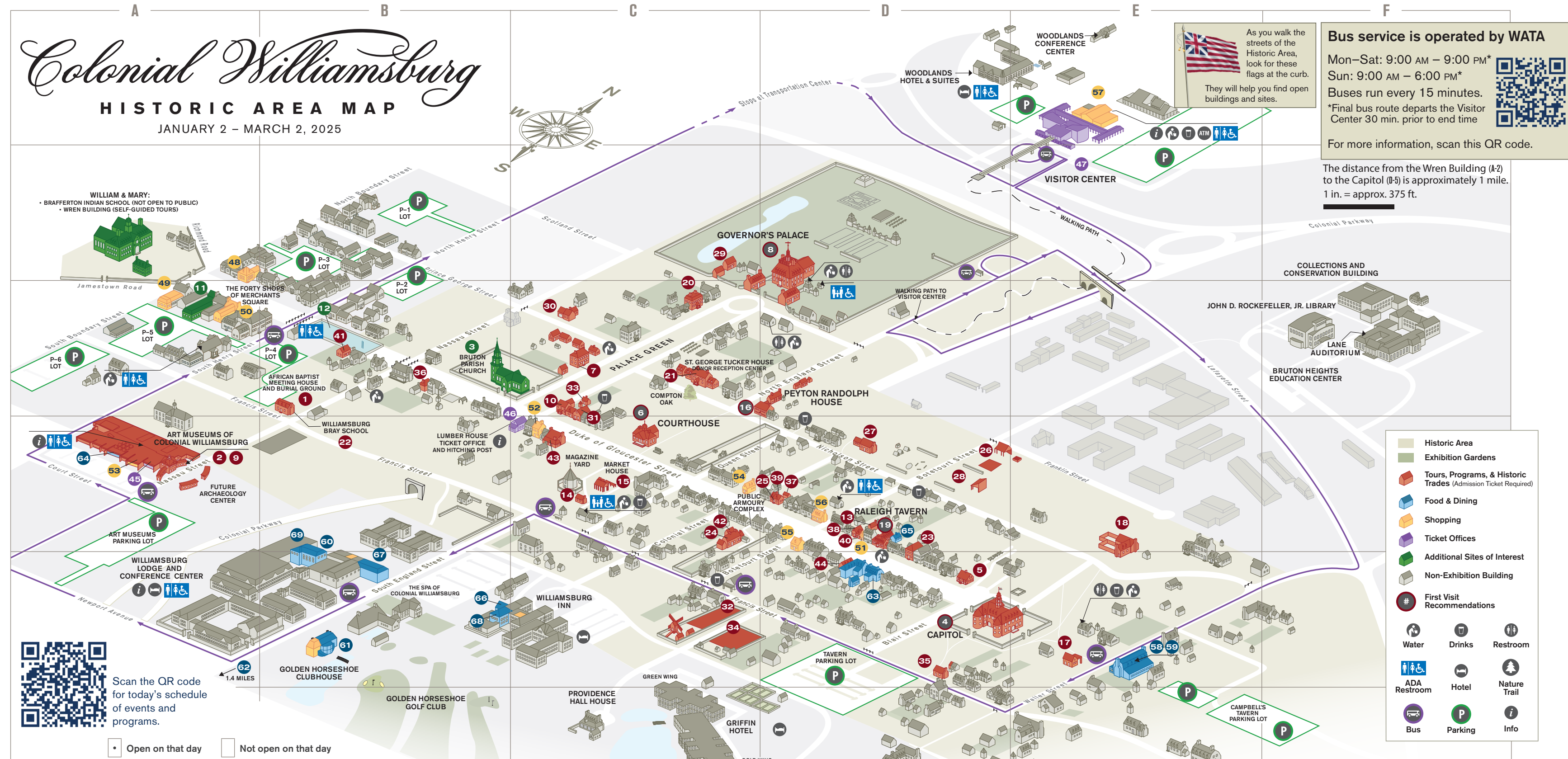
